Ephesians 1:1-6

1. Blessed by God's plan
2. Blessed by the Son's performance
3. Blessed by the spirit's presence

The first 6 verses show us that we are blessed because of:

1B. The SOURCE of this blessing - God the father
1 Cor. 4:6

2B. The SCOPE of this blessing - all or every
1 Peter 1:3-4
2 Peter 1:2-3

2A. THE PLAN OF GOD THAT MAKES IT POSSIBLE - 4-6

Verses 4-16 are one sentence, with one main verb: “Has blessed us”

1B. Based on God's own DECISION - 4
He chose us - Middle Aorist
John 15:16 Rom. 9:10

1C. God's choice operates according to his foreknowledge
1 Peter 1:2; Romans 8:29

2C. God's choice eliminates boasting
1 Corinthians 1:27; Romans 3:27-28

2B. Based on God's unique DESIGN for us - 5

1C. To adopt us as children
Romans 8:15
Adoption was a Roman ceremony.

" WE ARE BLESSED "

2C. To conform us to Christ's image. Holy and blameless
1 John 3:1-3; Romans 8:29

3B. Based on God's personal **DESIRE** - 5
Luke 12:32; Ephesians 1:9; Philippians 2:132; Thess. 1:11; Rev. 4:11

4B. Based on the **DEATH** of Jesus

Grace has made us accepted – graced us
The beloved is not a group of redeemed, it is the beloved one - Jesus

3A. THE **PURPOSES** OF GOD BEHIND THESE BLESSINGS – 4, 6

1B. **GUARANTEE** our perfection - 4
1 Peter 1:18-19

Holy and blameless

2B. **GIVE** understanding of God's love
“In love” having predestined

3B. **GLORIFY** his grace - 6
Romans 9:23-24; 2 Corinthians 4:15

1A. **THE PERSON WHO MAKES OUR REDEMPTION POSSIBLE**

“In Him we have redemption”

- Jesus is the object of God’s love. The beloved one.
- In love, having predestined us.

2A. **THE PRICE OF OUR REDEMPTION**

“through His blood” not just a metonym. There are bloodless deaths.

Acts 20:28

“Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood”

Romans 5:9

“Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him”

1 Cor. 6:20

“For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's”.

1 Corinthians 7:23 “Ye are bought with a price; be not ye the servants of men”.

Hebrews 9:12

“Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption”

"TO THE PRAISE OF HIS GLORY"

Message No. 2 - Ephesians 1:7-14

1 Peter 1:18-19

“knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot”

Revelation 5:9

“And they sang a new song, saying: You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, And have redeemed us to God by Your blood Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation”

Agora – Market place

On the slave block you could:

Buy a slave to own and use.

Buy a slave to set free

Buy a slave to set free and adopt.

“the forgiveness of sins”

Trespass - fallen to the side.

Colossians 1:14

in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

Titus 2:14

who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.

Revelation 1:5

and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood,

The Greek word for Forgiveness means to send away.

Day of Atonement. Two goats were used.

One was killed.

"TO THE PRAISE OF HIS GLORY"

Message No. 2 - Ephesians 1:7-14

One was let go in the wilderness.
Our sin is sent away.

Hebrews 13:12, 13

“Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate. 13 Let us go forth therefore unto him without the camp, bearing his reproach”.

“according to the riches of His grace which He made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence”

God’s resources become our abundant supply.

His wisdom is at work.

2 Corinthians 8:9

For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich.

Ephesians 2:8-9

For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.

Romans 3:24

“Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus”

Romans 11:5-6

Even so then, at this present time there is a remnant according to the election of grace. And if by grace, then it is no longer of works; otherwise grace is no longer grace. But if it is of works, it is no longer grace; otherwise work is no longer work.

Greek word for "House" and "law" "the law of the house"

4B. Based on God's **OBJECTIVE**

"that He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth - in Him"

Revelation 11:15

"Then the seventh angel sounded: And there were loud voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever"

5B. Based on God's **PURPOSE**

"In Him also we have obtained an inheritance"

Luke 12 "it is your fathers good pleasure to give you the kingdom".

6B. Based on God's **SOVEREIGNTY**

"being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will"

Romans 11:36

"For of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever. Amen"

Romans 1:16

"For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek"

Trusted – Greek "hope" with "before" - to hope beforehand

"TO THE PRAISE OF HIS GLORY"

Message No. 2 - Ephesians 1:7-14

7A. THE **PROMISE** OF REDEMPTION – 13-14

1B. Based on the **WORD** we believe

“In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation”

2B. Based on the **WORK** of the Holy Spirit

“in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory”

2 Corinthians 1:21-22

“Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us is God, who also has sealed us and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee”

Modern Greek uses this word for an engagement Ring

Romans 8:18 ff

“For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us. For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God. For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in hope; because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now. Not only that, but we also who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body.

Ephesians 1:15-23

Vv. **15-23** are one sentence as is **1-14**. 169 words.

1A. **PRAYER** IS ESSENTIAL TO ALL SPIRITUAL UNDERSTANDING - 15-18

2A. **THE PROMISES** OF GOD ARE REAL - 18

3A. **THE POWER** OF GOD IS GREAT - 19-23

1A. **PRAYER** IS ESSENTIAL TO ALL SPIRITUAL UNDERSTANDING - 15-18

1B. The **CAUSE** behind Paul’s prayer

1C. All that has gone before
“***Wherefore***”

2C. That which comes to us
“***I heard***”

We can’t feed the whole world but maybe we can feed those that God brings across our path.

3C. Their **Faith**
“***faith in the Lord Jesus***”

4C. Their **Love**
“***and love unto all saints***”

2B. The **CHARACTERISTICS** of his prayer

1C. **Faithful**
“do not cease” ***Thess. 5:17*** “Pray without ceasing”

Philippians 1:3 I thank my God upon every remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine making request for you all with joy

2C. **Personal**
“***of you***” not just “God bless the missionaries”

3C. **Thankful**
“***to give thanks for you making mention of you in my prayers***”
It means our hearts are in tune with God’s plan.

"WHAT WE NEED TO KNOW"
Message No. 3 - Ephesians 1:15-23

Philippians 1:7-8 just as it is right for me to think this of you all, because I have you in my heart, inasmuch as both in my chains and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel, you all are partakers with me of grace. For God is my witness, how greatly I long for you all with the affection of Jesus Christ.

Philippians 4:6

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God

3B. The **CONCERN** of his prayer - 17-18

1C. Spiritual **knowledge**

"that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him"

2C. Spiritual **Light**

"the eyes of your understanding being enlightened"

1A. PRAYER IS ESSENTIAL TO ALL SPIRITUAL UNDERSTANDING - 15-18

2A. THE PROMISES OF GOD ARE REAL - 18

1B. A true **CALLING** - hope

"that you may know what is the hope of His calling"

Colossians 1:27 "To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory"

1 Corinthians 1:9 "God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord"

Romans 8:18-25; Hebrews 6:13-19

2B. A true **INHERITANCE**

"what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints".

Rom. 8:31-32; 1 Pet. 1:4

Not just material riches - the riches of God himself.

“and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power which He wrought in Christ”

strength - displayed

might – inherent

2B. The EVIDENCE of the greatness of His power

1C. Christ's Resurrection

“when He raised Him from the dead”

2C. Christ's Exhalation

“and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places”

Ephesians 2:6 “and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus”

3C. Christ's Authority

“far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come”

4C. Christ's Position

“And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church”

Colossians 1:15 “He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation”

5C. Christ's Preeminence

“which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all”

Ephesians 2:1-10

3 questions we need to ask.

- 1A. *WHY IS SALVATION BY GRACE NEEDED? - 1-3*
- 2A. *HOW DOES SALVATION BY GRACE HAPPEN? - 4-9*
- 3A. *WHAT DOES IT ACCOMPLISH? - 10*

1A. WHY IS SALVATION BY GRACE NEEDED? - 1-3

1B. Our spiritual **CONDITION** demanded it
“And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins”

Trespass 23 times sins 270

Being dead means not being able to respond.

ILL. The funeral where everyone came to check if the guy was dead. Stuck pins in him.

Ephesians 5:14 “Therefore He says: Awake, you who sleep, Arise from the dead, And Christ will give you light”

4 things about being spiritually dead.

1C. Inability to **See** spiritual truth

2C. Inability to **Seek** help from God

Psalms 66:18 If I regard iniquity in my heart, The Lord will not hear.

Isaiah 59:1-2 Behold, the LORD’s hand is not shortened, That it cannot save; Nor His ear heavy, That it cannot hear. But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear.

3C. Inability to **Produce** true good

James 2:17, 26; Romans 3:12 They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one.

4C. Inability to **Respond** to God personally

1 Timothy 5:5

"BY GRACE WE ARE SAVED"
Message No. 4 - Ephesians 2:1-10

2B. Our personal **CONDUCT** demanded it - 2-3a

1C. Worldly **Atmosphere**

"in which you once walked according to the course of this world"

Course means to breath in. Literally atmosphere, Smog.

1D. **Music**

2D. **Movies**

2C. Satanic **Authority**

"according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience"

Prince of the authority of the air - a spirit of the world.

The sons of **the** disobedience - Adams disobedience

I'll do what I want not want God says. Children do this to parents.

3C. Fleshly **Attitudes** and **Activities**

"among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind"

Lust is in us all. Our flesh demands that we fulfill its lust.

3B. The **CONSEQUENCES** we face - 3b

"and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others"

Romans 5:8

John 3:18 "He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God"

John 3:36 "He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

1 Thessalonians 1:10 "and to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, even Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come"

1 Thessalonians 5:9 "For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ"

1B. Based on the **ATTRIBUTES** of God - 4

“But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us”

Mercy and Love. Love Past tense - the cross

1 John 4:9-10

“In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him. In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins”

1 John 4:19

“We love Him because He first loved us”

2B. Based on the **ACTS** of God - 5-6

Before we had a chance to merit salvation

“even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus”

1C. Made us alive - 5

2C. Raised us up - 6

3C. Made us sit - 6

Hebrews 1:3-4 “who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, having become so much better than the angels, as He has by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they”

3B. Based on the **AIM** of God for the future - 7

“that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus”

4B. Based on the **ACCEPTANCE** of God’s Gift - 8-9

"BY GRACE WE ARE SAVED"

Message No. 4 - Ephesians 2:1-10

"For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast".

1C. **Prerequisite** - have faith

2C. **Purpose** - guard against boasting

1A. *WHY IS SALVATION BY GRACE NEEDED? - 1-3*

2A. *HOW DOES SALVATION BY GRACE HAPPEN? - 4-9*

3A. *WHAT DOES IT ACCOMPLISH? - 10*

1B. **CREATES** a new life

"For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works"

2 Cor. 5:17

Workmanship – Greek "*Poema*" - Poem

2B. **COMPLETES** the original plan of God

"which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them"

EPHESIANS

Therefore - because of salvation by grace - We have access! GRACE:

1A. **BRINGS** GENTILES TO GOD - 11-13

1B. The **CONDITION** we were in - 11-12

Alienation - far off. Cf. *Mark 12:34; Luke 15:20; Acts 2:38*

1C. **Uncircumcised**

The Jews would shake the dust off their feet if soiled by gentile ground.

2C. **Alienated**

1D. **Christless**

2D. **Stateless**

3D. **Friendless**

4D. **Hopeless**

5D. **Godless**

2B. The **CURE** we received - 13

1C. **Reconciliation** - brought near

2C. **Atonement** - the blood of Christ

2A. **BREAKS** DOWN THE BARRIER - 14-15A

1B. A **LEGAL** wall

God's peculiar people - rules made them different

2B. A **LITERAL** wall in the temple

"ACCESS TO GOD"
Message No. 5 - Ephesians 2:11-18

1A. BRINGS GENTILES TO GOD - 11-13

2A. BREAKS DOWN THE BARRIER - 14-15a

3A. **BEGINS** A NEW RELATIONSHIP - 15B-18

1B. Through the **WORK** God had done - 15-16

1C. **Creates** a new man - 15
2 Corinthians 5:17-21

2C. **Reconciles** both Jew and Gentiles - 16
Restoring back to a previous condition - Adam before the fall.

2B. Through the **WORD** he preached - 17
Phil. 3:1-2

3B. Through the **WAY** we come to the father - 18
*Romans 5:1-2; John 10:9; John 14:6; 1 Timothy 2:5; Hebrews 4:14-16;
10:19-22; 11:6*

Ephesians 2:19-22

- 1A. *THE **PEOPLE** WHO ARE INVOLVED –19*
- 2A. *THE **PREREQUISITES** NEEDED – 20*
- 3A. *THE **PROCESS** IN BUILDING THE CHURCH – 21*
- 4A. *THE **PURPOSE** THAT IS ACHIEVED – 22*

Therefore - Because you are now one by the work of Christ on the cross:

1A. THE **PEOPLE** WHO ARE INVOLVED - 19

- 1B. An old **PROBLEM** removed by the cross
Acts 15, Acts 10, Cf. v.12, 19 - zenos strangers

Foreigners – “to settle along side of” *1 Pet. 1:1; 2:11*

- 2B. A new **PRIVILEGE** made possible by the cross
Heb. 11:9-16; 12:22-24, 10:24

Acts 2:41 – receive the word and be baptized.

2A. THE **PREREQUISITES** NEEDED - 20

- 1B. The **FOUNDATION**

- 1C. **Apostles**

- 2C. **Prophets** not Old testament cf. 3:5

Granville Sharp’s rule of Greek Grammar. When two nouns are joined by the conjunction “and” and the first noun has the article but the second one does not, the two nouns are equals or synonymous.

“*holy*” special group set apart for giving these revelations.
Rev. 1:1; Heb. 1:1-2; Rev 22:18-19

Revelation completes the scriptures and gives us the story of the future, past the millenium and into the new heaven and earth. It’s complete.

1A. ***THE RESPONSIBILITY GIVEN TO PAUL - 1-2***

1B. The ***ATTITUDE*** toward his imprisonment - 1
Acts 21:17-20; 28:28; Philippians 1:12-14

1C. Gentiles were being saved - ***Phil. 4:22***

2C. Christians were getting bold

3C. Paul had time to write 4 letters

2B. The ***ACCOUNTABILITY*** he felt toward God - 2
1 Corinthians 4:1-2

Stewardship, dispensation. A responsibility to tell what he was told by God.

Lepers and the Assyrian spoils. ***2 Kings 7:8-9***. Don't keep it to yourselves.

2A. ***THE REVELATION HE HAD FROM GOD - 3-7*** ***Gal. 1:11-16***

1B. Called a mystery - 3-6
Eph. 1:9; Col. 1:26-27

1C. Something not known before but now revealed

2C. Mystery religions. Recruit through secrets
New age thinking is related to the mystery religions of the past.

2B. It's effect on Paul - 7
Based on two things:

1C. God's Grace

2C. God's Power

Vs. 5:15 says ***“walk circumspectly”*** – mathematics terms for accurately.

The passage deals with ***“How to”*** get along.

 5. We are afraid of losing our own authority, independence, and possessions
Out of 50 remarried couples surveyed, not one of them had consolidated their finances into the category of Mr. And Mrs.
 6. We are afraid the other person will take advantage of us.
 7. The real reason we don’t submit: ***Romans. 8:4; Galatians 5:16***

Dr. Armon Nicholi Jr. of the Harvard Medical School gives five trends that are tearing our families apart.

1. Quick and easy divorce.
2. Married woman with young children working outside the home.
3. The tendency of the culture to view the role of parent as passe.
4. The tendency to move frequently because the job is most important.
5. The intrusion of the television set has had a negative effect on families.

Healthy families :

1. Have parents with a high commitment to the family.
2. Find time to spend together.
3. Provide a spiritual dimension.
 - a. Establishes priorities in relationship with God and family.
 - b. Faith gives a new standard for relationships based on love that is based on the will, self-sacrifice and self denial – not feelings.

Marriage, Family, and Business are all effected. The key issue is still submission. God is more interested in how we do what we do than what we do in business.

1A. HOW **EMPLOYEES** SHOULD **RESPOND** TO THOSE OVER THEM – 5-8

The gentile church was composed of mostly slaves. They had no rights of their own. They were to obey. “to hear under”.

“be obedient”

“according to the flesh” obey unless they ask us to violate spiritual principles.

2B. Respond with **SENSITIVITY** to your boss and duties

“singleness” of motive in work ,not duplicity. *Tit. 2:9; Col. 3:22*

4B. Respond with **SERVICE** that is rooted in a relationship with Christ –6-7
“not with eye service but as servants of Christ”

3. Understand the subject and use it for good.

1A. OUR GREATEST **NEED** – 10

“Be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might”. Cf. *Eph. 1:19; 3:16, 20*.

We tend to trust in our own strengths. Why don't we trust God's power?

1B. We underestimate Satan's power
We are lulled into complacency.

2B. We overestimate our own abilities

3B. We fail to understand and apply God's resources
Isa. 40:28

Jesus said to “watch and to pray lest we enter temptation” “the flesh is weak”.

2A. THE **NECESSITY** FOR SPIRITUAL POWER – 11-12

“Stand” is used 4 times and is the opposite of “moved”. *Psa. 16:8*

1B. Because of the **TACTICS** of the enemy
“wiles” – methods, tactics

1C. He gets us to fight against each another
vs. 12 says literally “the struggle in us is not against blood and flesh”.

All struggles are spiritual, the flesh is just the trigger - *James 3:13; 4:2*

2C. He blinds us to the spiritual backdrop
Eph. 1:21; 3:10; Col. 1:16, 2:10, 15; 2 Cor. 4:3-6

2B. Because of the **TEMPTATIONS** we must face
Chapter *5:16* “evil day” - really wicked day - an onslaught
1 Cor. 10:11-13. Why temptation? *1 Pet. 5:8*
